Fieldwork	Working outside to collect information
Local area	The area around where you live
Village	Villages are small settlements. They have a small number of houses. Some villages have a shop, a church and a school
Town	A town is bigger than a village. Normally a few thousand people live there. There are more shops and houses as well as schools, places of worship and leisure facilities
City	Cities are bigger than towns and can be home to large amounts of people. They often have a range of places of worship, shopping centres and sports facilities
Human feature	A human feature is something that has been built by humans including buildings, bridges and roads
Physical feature	Physical features are natural features such as rivers, mountains and seas
Aerial view	What somewhere would look like from above, looking down

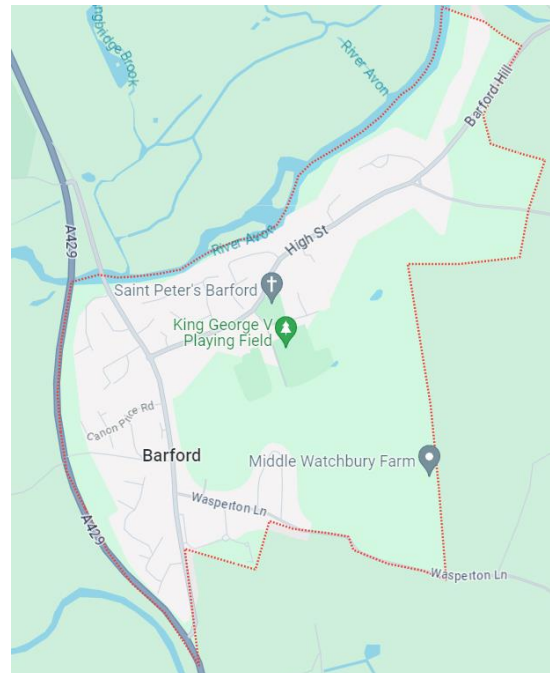

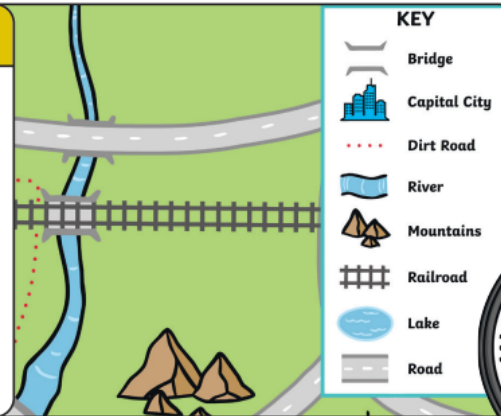

## Maps

- A view from above a place
- Sometimes have a key with symbols
- Show the **distance** between places
- Sometimes have a compass
- Can use colour



Symbols show what different things or places can be found in an area.

## Compass

A compass can be used to help you find your way. It shows four directions - north, east, south and west. It is useful to people who are, for example, navigating ships and aircraft, explorers, builders, etc.
