### Introduction

Welcome to Barford St. Peters Pre-School, we hope that this information booklet is useful for you. We are housed in a purpose-built Foundation stage unit that is part of Barford St. Peters C.E. Primary School in the village of Barford.

We have a capacity for 24 places each session and take children from the age of three. Please see our admissions policy for further details.

We welcome your child into our school community and working in partnership with you to ensure that their life at Barford St. Peter's Pre-School proves to be a very happy, stimulating and rewarding experience.



## Starting Pre-School

Having booked your child's place at Barford St. Peter's Pre-School, you will receive an email the term before your child starts. This will include the date your child is due to join us and details of the sessions you have booked. You will be invited to book a taster session for your child a few weeks before they start. The sessions will last roughly an hour this gives you and your child an opportunity to meet your key person and the Pre-School team.

### Things your child will need for Pre-School

- An appropriate coat to suit the weather
- Labelled suitable spare clothes in case of accidents
- PE trainers (PE Day Only)
- Wellington boots
- Suitable bag/rucksack
- Water bottle containing water ONLY
- Nappies/Wipes if required
- Indoor shoes (croc's preferred)

### Our Sessions

We offer morning and afternoon sessions at our Pre-School. Our morning sessions start at 8:30am until 11:30. Our afternoon sessions start at 12:00pm until 3:00pm with the option to stay till 3:15pm.

We also offer 'all day sessions' depending on availability which is 8:30am – 3:15pm. We recommend your child does at least two sessions per week, we find this helps your child to settle into Pre-School and will help your child to build positive relationships with their peers.

We also offer funded only sessions with no additional charge, please do speak to our team about these sessions.

If your child attends our afternoon sessions, then they will be here for lunch time. You can order a hot lunch for your child which is prepared on site. Or if preferred you may want to supply your child with a healthy packed lunch. We are a nut free school, so we ask for NO nuts to be in lunch boxes.

### Funding Information

### Outdoor Provision

During your child's time at Barford St. Peters Pre-School your child will spend much of their day outdoors. We run a free-flow system throughout the day, so your child has the choice between playing indoors or outdoors. We believe children learn best from playing outdoors.

We have our very own mud area in our outdoor area which has a mud kitchen and different tools for your child to explore. We also use the Forest school area which is on the school's field. We follow the children's own interests and plan different outdoor activities whilst at forest school. We always ask for your child to come into Pre-school wearing sensible clothes as we love to get messy outdoors!

On our large field we also have chickens who frequently lay eggs and a kitchen garden where we grow a variety of different fruit and vegetables.

### Curriculum

Barford St. Peter's Pre-School supports all children in developing at their own pace. We realise the importance for children to have rich and stimulating experiences within the learning environment and provide many opportunities for the children to explore, experiment, plan and make decisions, therefore enabling them to learn and develop.

Our activities are mainly child-led with a hint of adult-led, we organise our sessions so that the children can choose from, and work at, a range of activities and in doing so, build up their ability to select and work through a task to its completion. The children are also helped and encouraged to take part in large group activities which introduce them to new experiences and help them to gain new skills, as well as helping them to learn to work with others.

### Observations & Reports

To track and assess your child's progress we use an online software package called 'Tapestry'. Your child will receive regular observations a week which you also have access to. You will receive a letter explaining Tapestry and how you can create an account.

We also do a baseline assessment within the first few weeks of your child starting with us, this will include assessing your child in the areas of learning.
