School Uniform

At Barford St. Peter's we believe that wearing smart school uniform promotes a sense of identity and pride in children.

Please ensure that all uniform items are **clearly named** to ensure that they can always be returned to your child if they are mislaid.

List of Uniform – Reception & Key Stage One

- A white shirt or white polo shirt
- An optional school tie – clip on or elasticated are available from the school office.
- Grey trousers, shorts or skirt, or pinafore dress
- A red school sweatshirt or red cardigan
- Grey or white socks, red or grey tights
- Smart, polishable black shoes (**NOT trainers or soft sided shoes**)
- A red and white dress during the summer months

P.E Kit

Children should have the following kit in a drawstring bag clearly marked with their name:

- Black shorts
- Black plain round-neck t-shirt or Barford logo t-shirt
- Black plimsolls or black trainers

In addition to this, during the winter months for outdoor P.E. children may also wear:

- Black outdoor trainers
- Plain, black jogging bottoms
- Plain, black hooded zip top or Barford quarter zip top

Jewellery & Hairbands

In the interests of safety, pupils will only be allowed to wear a simple, comfortable watch to school. NO SMART WATCHES are allowed. No other jewellery should be worn to school other than for religious reasons. Children with pierced ears should wear plain, flat, studs only. However, earring must be removed for PE and for swimming. Hair bands must be white, red or black.

Please note that nail varnish and extreme hair styles are not permitted. Long hair should be tied back.

Please note that 'air up' water bottles are not permitted. Children must bring water only in their water bottles. Squash is not permitted.

Enforcement of School Uniform Policy

If a pupil is not wearing the correct school uniform, including black school shoes, parents will be sent a reminder letter. If a breach of the uniform policy continues, parents will be contacted to discuss the reasons for the uniform breach.

If a child continues to breach the uniform policy in relation to school shoes, they will be provided with plain, black pumps to change into during school hours.
