



School Uniform

At Barford St. Peter's we believe that wearing smart school uniform promotes a sense of identity and pride in children.

Please ensure that all uniform items are **clearly named** to ensure that they can always be returned to your child if they are mislaid.

List of Uniform – Reception & Key Stage One

- A white shirt or white polo shirt
- An optional school tie – clip on or elasticated are available from the school office.
- Grey trousers, shorts or skirt, or pinafore dress
- A red school sweatshirt or red cardigan
- Grey or white socks, red or grey tights
- Smart, black shoes (**NOT trainers or soft sided shoes**)
- A red and white dress during the summer months
- A red fleece for outdoor use (optional)

P.E Kit

Children should have the following kit in a drawstring bag clearly marked with their name:

- Red shorts
- White round-neck t-shirt (logo t-shirts are available)
- Black plimsolls or black trainers

In addition to this, during the winter months for outdoor P.E. children may also wear:

- Black outdoor trainers
- Plain, black jogging bottoms
- Plain, black hooded zip top

You can collect a school book bag, drawstring PE bag, and school water bottle during the Reception induction evening. Alternatively, they are available from the School Office. Payment for these should be made online via ParentPay, once your account is active.

Jewellery & Hairbands

In the interests of safety, pupils will only be allowed to wear a simple, comfortable watch to school. **NO SMART WATCHES** are allowed. No other jewellery should be worn to school. Children with pierced ears should wear plain, flat, studs only. However, earring must be removed for PE and for swimming. Hair bands must be white, red or black.

Please note that nail varnish and extreme hair styles are not permitted. Long hair should be tied back.

Please note that 'air up' water bottles are not permitted. Children must bring water only in their water bottles. Squash is not permitted.
